**POSITION:** ASSISTANT PROFESSOR/PROGRAM COORDINATOR AUTOMOTIVE HONDA PACT  
(Full-time, 10-month, tenure track position).

**MINIMUM  
QUALIFICATIONS:** Bachelor's degree and four (4) years teaching experience in an automotive technology field; Five (5) years' work experience as a certified Honda or Acura technical professional working in either or all of the following positions: Honda or Acura automotive repair technician, Honda or Acura field representative, and/or Honda or Acura field engineer; and current ASE certifications: A1-A8, L1, required. Current CT driver's license with no limitations for operating a motor vehicle.

Applicants who do not meet the minimum qualifications as stated are encouraged to put in writing precisely how their background and experience have prepared them for the responsibilities of this position and by providing appropriate references. Exceptions to the degree requirements may be made for compelling reasons.

**DESIRED  
QUALIFICATIONS:** Teaching experience. Experience using education enrollment and learning platforms such as Banner and Blackboard. Ability to communicate and work effectively with an ethnically and culturally diverse campus community, including the demonstrated ability to respond to and work with diverse and varied student populations.

**PREFERRED  
QUALIFICATIONS:** Master's degree and ten (10) years full-time experience in the automotive field. Corporate technician certification instructor training; Honda PACT program knowledge. Current Honda or Acura certifications and assessments required to teach Honda PACT specific ASE A1-A8 subjects, and Honda or Acura corporate management experience. Community College teaching experience.

**RESPONSIBILITIES:** Under the supervision of the chairperson of the Automotive department, this Instructor/PC is responsible for the preparation and teaching of all assigned courses, scheduling of classes, assignment of instructors, evaluation of instructors and all responsibilities (subject to collective bargaining) pertaining to teaching faculty and program coordinator, curriculum design, and program supervision and development. In addition, the incumbent will be responsible for the coordination, periodic review, continued development, and general effectiveness of the Honda PACT Program which includes outreach and recruiting to area high schools and other sources for potential students. The incumbent will be required to maintain their ASE, Honda and Acura certifications; maintain relationship with periodic visits with Honda/Acura dealerships and corporate representatives; attend conferences that may be held outside the state of CT; establish, coordinate, oversee and visit student internships that are conducted throughout the year.

Teaching schedule may include evenings and/or weekends. Additional responsibilities include the development of and participation in the following: advisement and registration for students, special college projects, working on new instructional techniques, course and program development, and other college and community service activities consistent with a strong commitment to the Community College Mission. This position requires the instructor to participate in commencement ceremonies, convocation activities, and special college meetings.
