

GATEWAY COMMUNITY COLLEGE RADIOGRAPHY PROGRAM PROGRAM EFFECTIVENESS DATA

In addition to the goals and student learning outcomes listed elsewhere on this site, the performance of the program is reflected through program effectiveness data as defined by the Joint Review Committee on Education in Radiologic Technology (JRCERT) (20 N. Wacker Drive, Suite 2850, Chicago, IL 60606-3182, 312-704-5300, www.jrcert.org, mail@jrcert.org). Program effectiveness data includes the program completion rate, credentialing examination pass rate and job placement rate. Explanations of these measures and program data that correspond with the annual report most recently submitted to the JRCERT are noted below. Program Completion Rate:

Program completion rate is calculated by dividing the number of students who complete the Program by the number of students who began the Program.

| Year | Percent Completion | Number of Students |

Credentialing Examination Pass Rate:

The credentialing examination pass rate is the number of graduates who, on the first attempt, pass the American Registry of Radiologic Technologists certification exam. A five-year **average** credentialing examination pass rate of not less than 75 percent at first attempt is required by the JRCERT.

Job Placement Rate:

The job placement rate is the number of graduates who found employment in the field within twelve months of graduation compared to those actively seeking employment in the field. A five-year average job placement rate of not less than 75 percent within twelve months of graduation is required by the JRCERT.

| Year | Percent Job Placement | Number of Students |
|---|------------------------------|--|
| 2013 | 80% | 5 of 17 graduates completed graduate survey. 4 of 5 respondents employed within 6 months of graduation. |
| 2014 | 100% | 19 of 23 graduates completed graduate survey. 19 of 19 respondents employed within 12 months of graduation. |
| 2015 | 100% | 19 of 21 graduates completed graduate survey. 19 of 19 respondents employed within 12 months of graduation. |
| 2016 | 100% | 10 of 18 graduates completed graduate survey. 10 of 10 respondents employed within 12 months of graduation |
| 2017 | 100% | 9 of *18 graduates completed graduate survey. 9 of 9 respondents employed within 12 months of graduation. |
| 5 year average based on raw data | 99.6% | 59 students responded to survey as actively looking for employment. 58 found employment within 6 - 12 months of graduation |
